Sport For Choice is a project designed to create out of school sporting opportunities for young people with a visual impairment between the ages of 8 and 16. The project has been created by Andy Dalby-Welsh (England Blind Cricketer) with the partnership of the Blatchington Court Trust.

The project started Easter 2004 with activities such as, football, cricket, judo, swimming and trampolining. Since then other activities have included skiing, golf, water skiing and a five day residential trip to Little Canada on the Isle of Wight.

The activities are held at weekends, half terms, and the Easter and summer holidays. A residential outward bound trip is organised in the half term of the summer term. Activities are normally part of one, two or three day programmes depending on which school holiday they are in.
